

## Fee Guidelines for Licensing Cases

Below are guideline fees for the most common types of licensing cases. These are estimates of potential fees for barristers ranging from junior tenant through to Queen's Counsel.

There a number of different factors which may influence the fees charged, including, but not limited to, hearing length and complexity of the case.

Stage of case	Ranges of fixed fees (estimates)
Written advice on your application.	£500 – £1,500 + VAT
Preparation, including meetings with you and assistance with drafting of application.	£650 – £2,000 + VAT
Local authority licensing committee hearing.	£500 – £10,000 + VAT
Appeal to the Magistrates' Court – initial hearing.	£350 – £2,500 + VAT
Appeal to the Magistrates' Court – full hearing.	£750 – £20,000 + VAT
